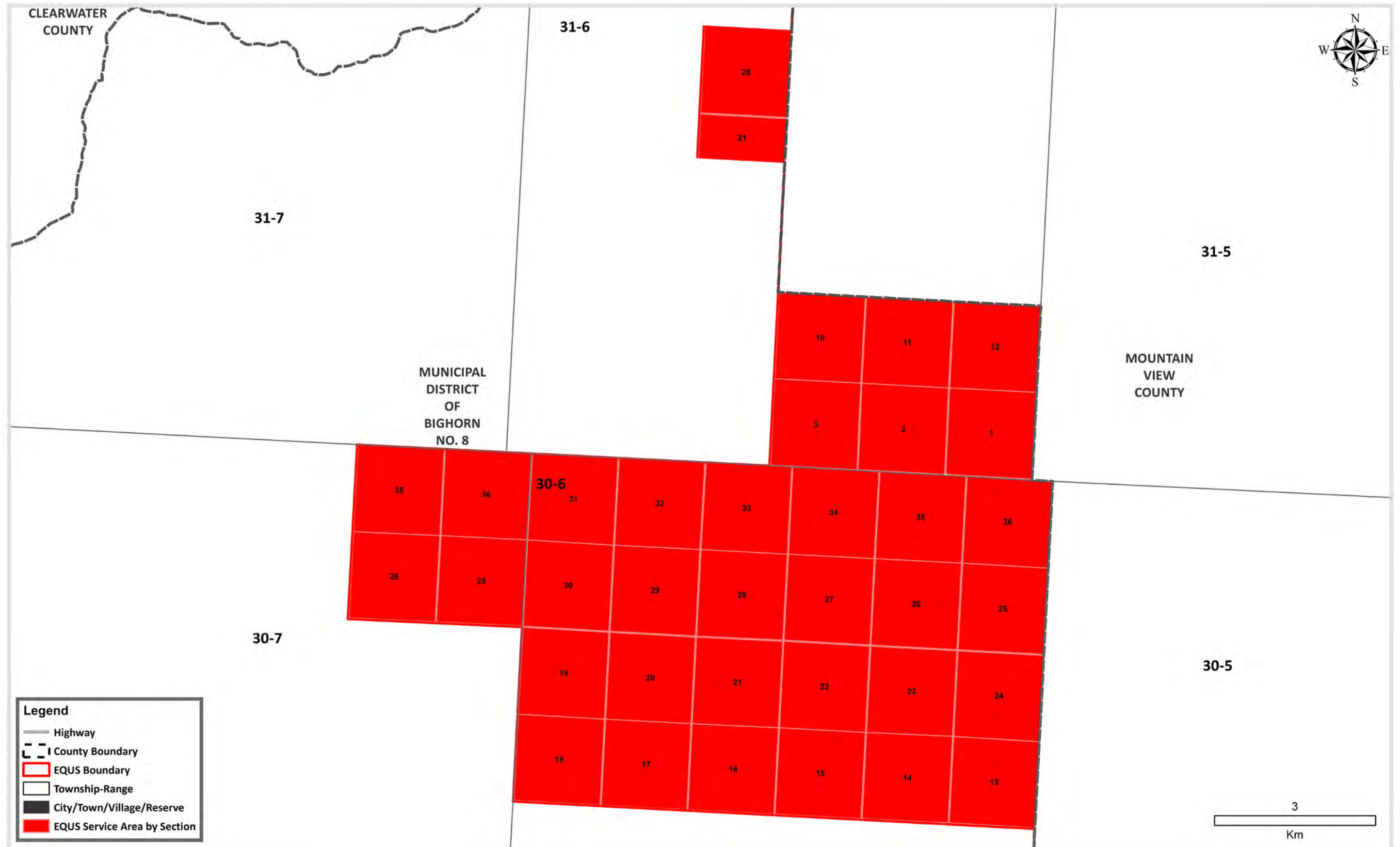






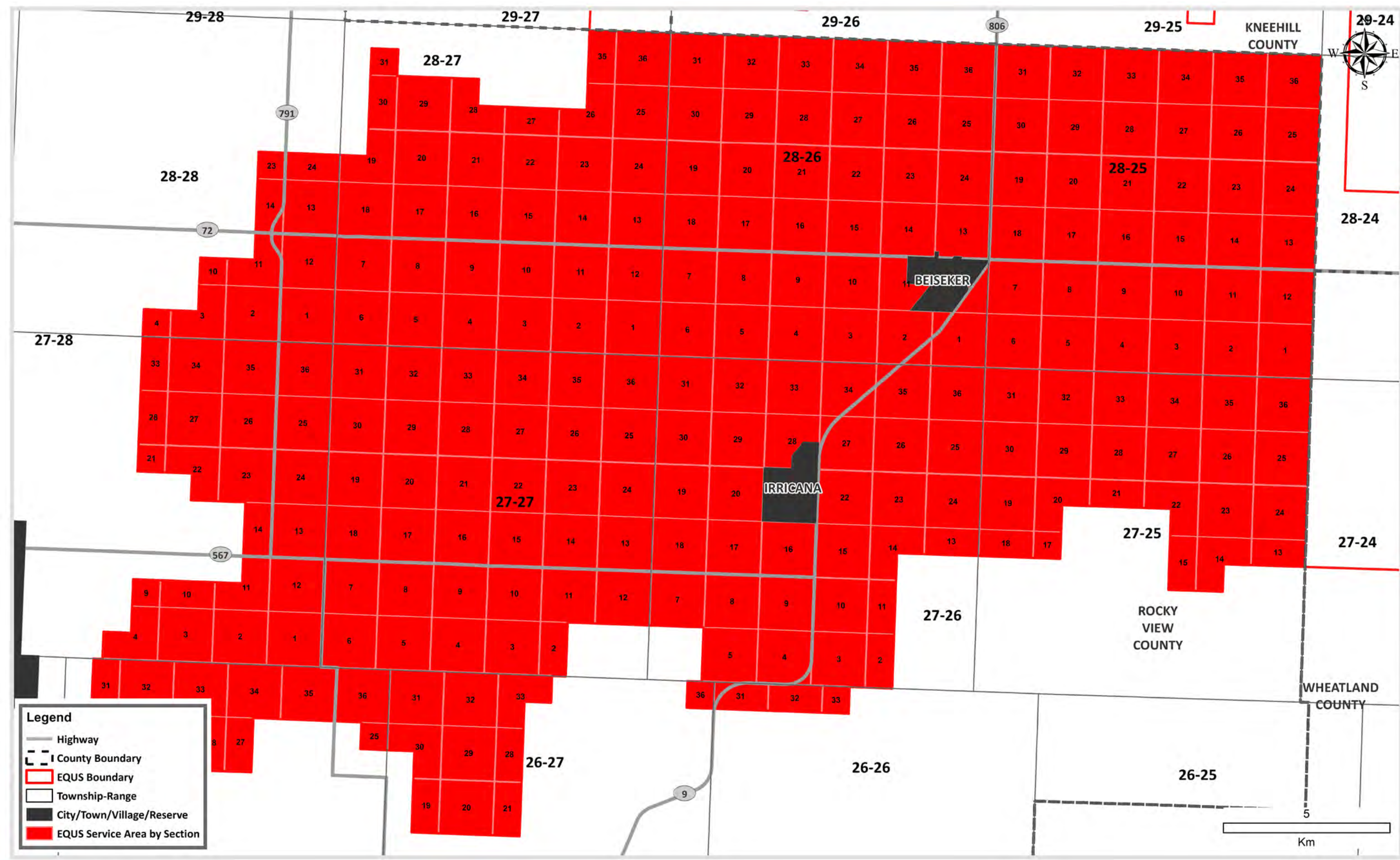


# MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF BIGHORN NO. 8



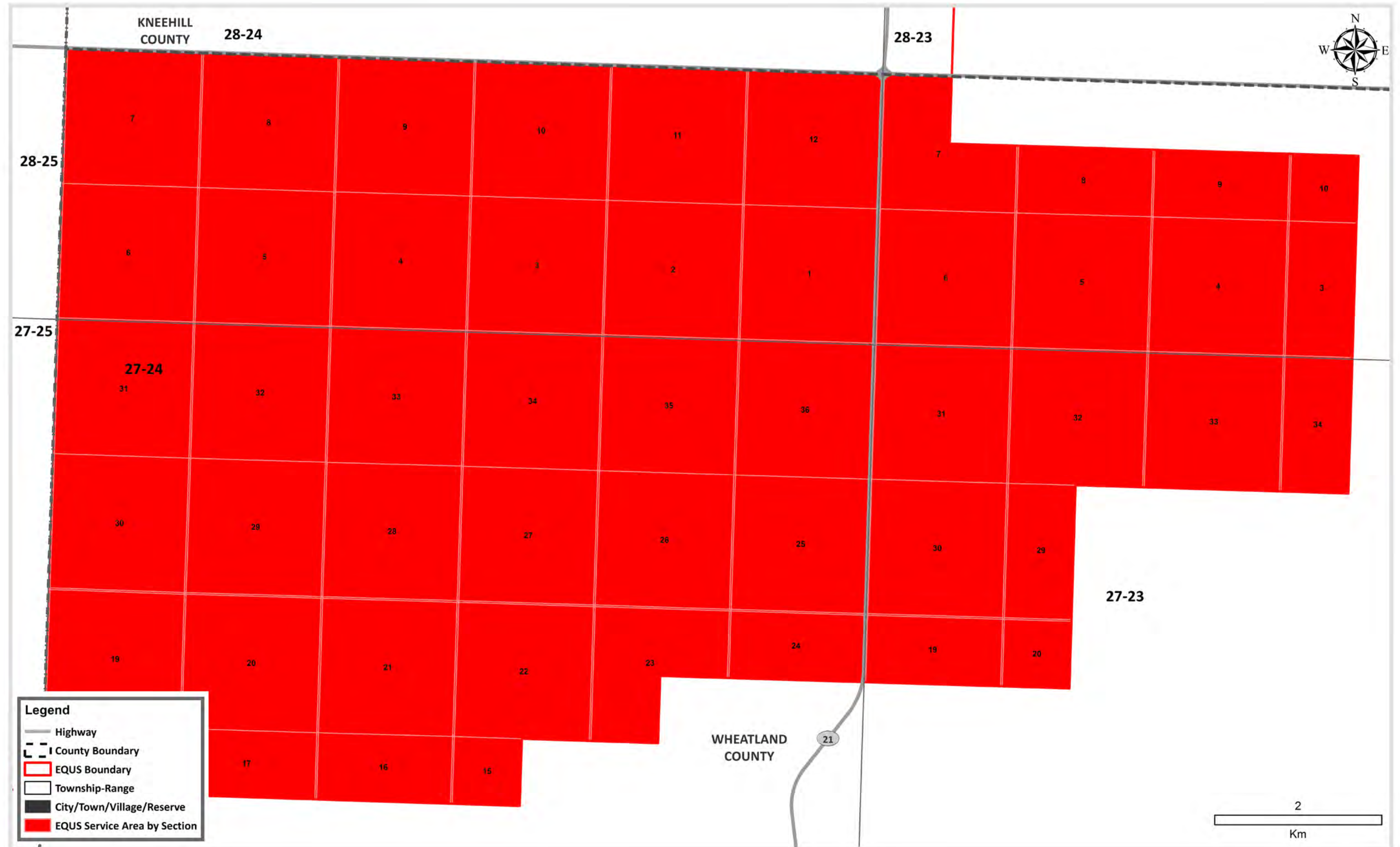

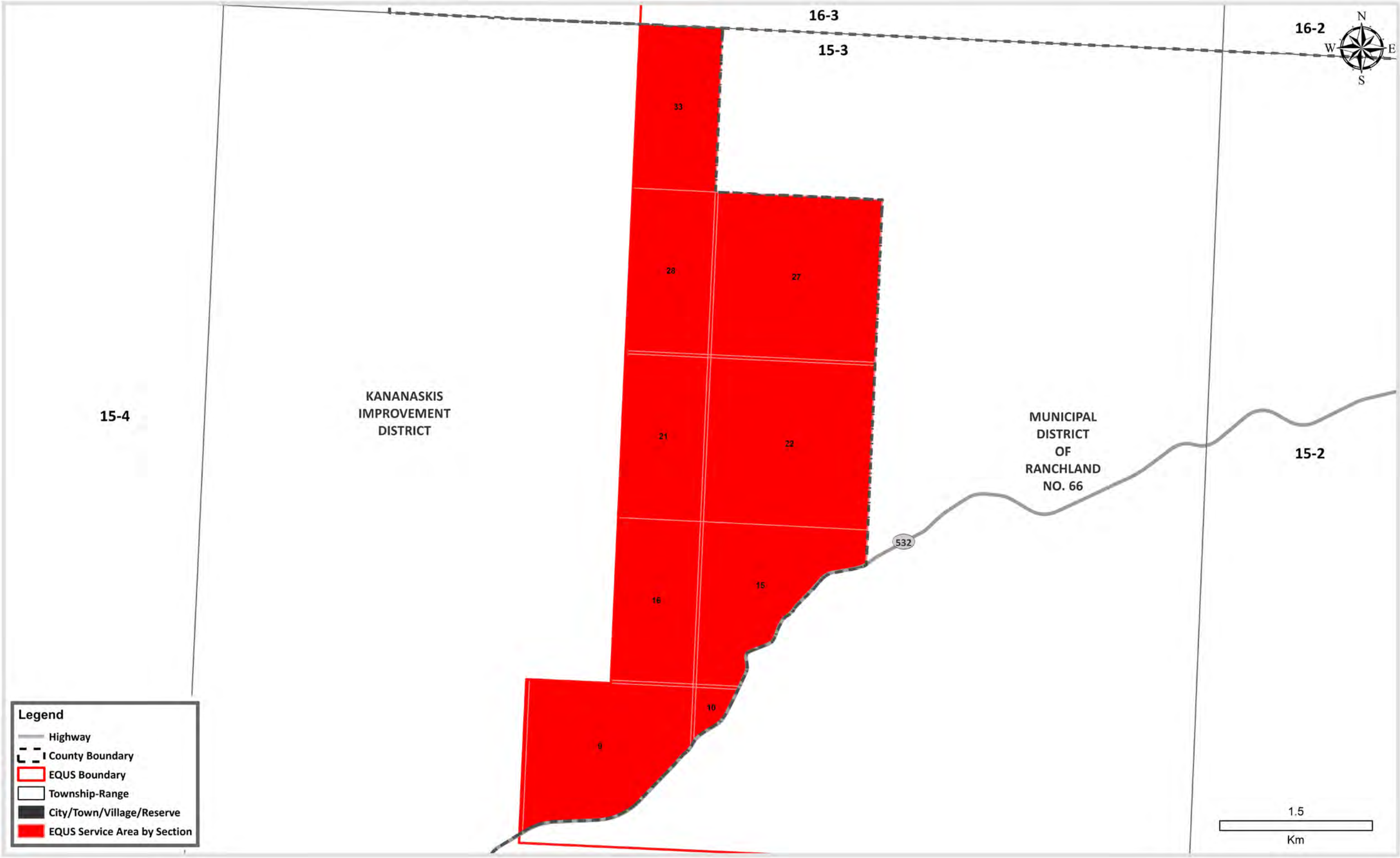


# MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF FOOTHILLS NO. 31



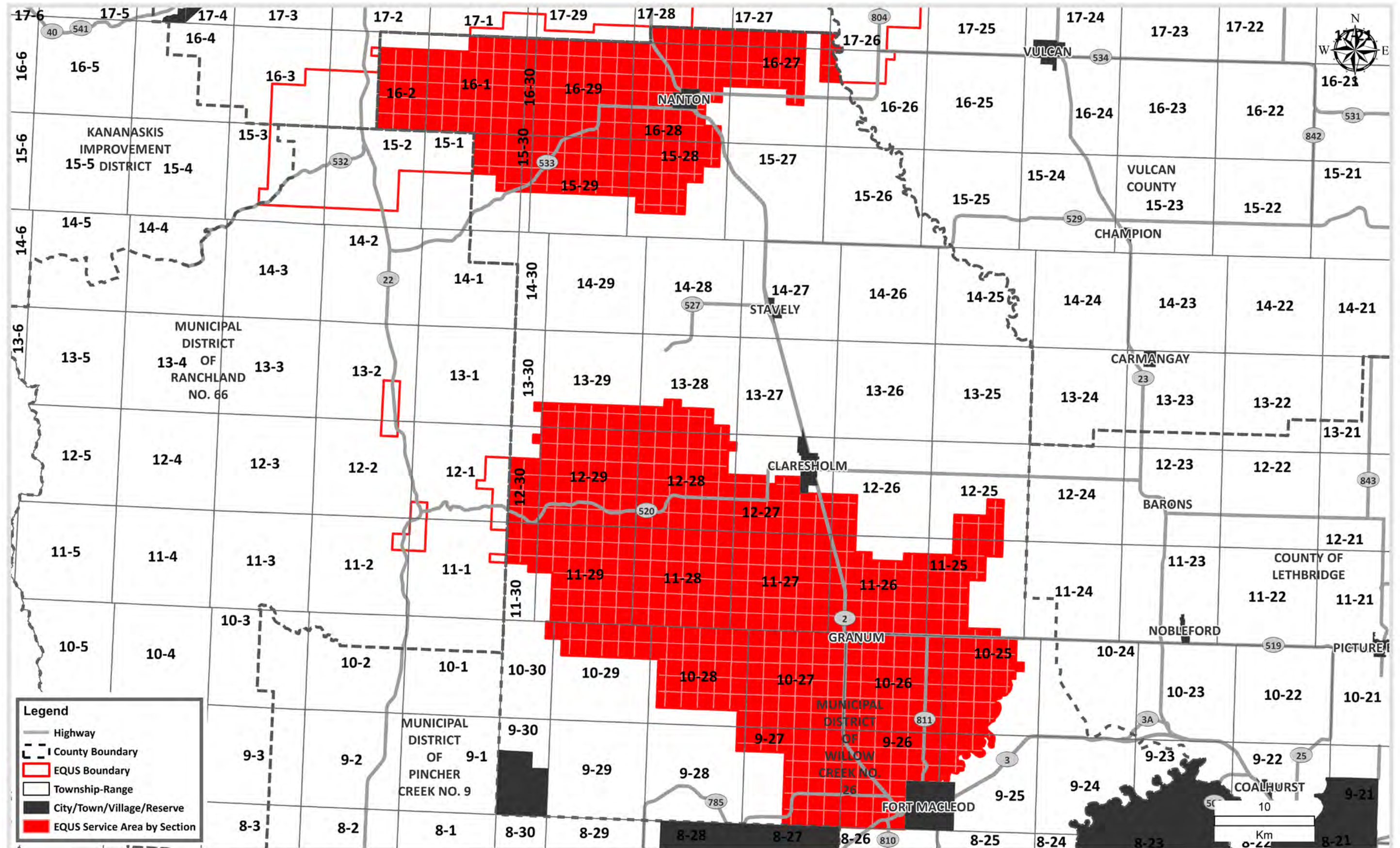


# KANANASKIS IMPROVEMENT AREA



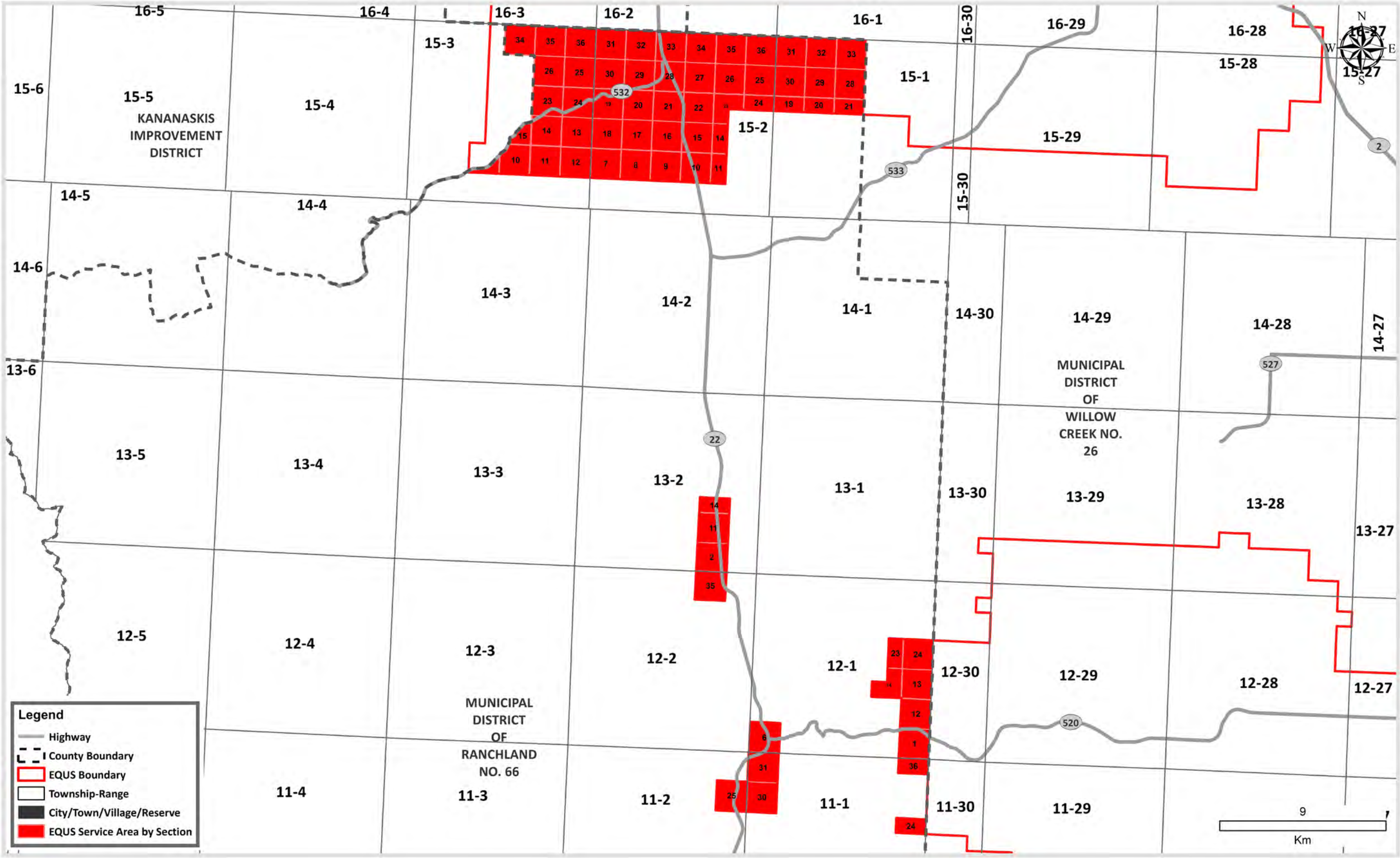

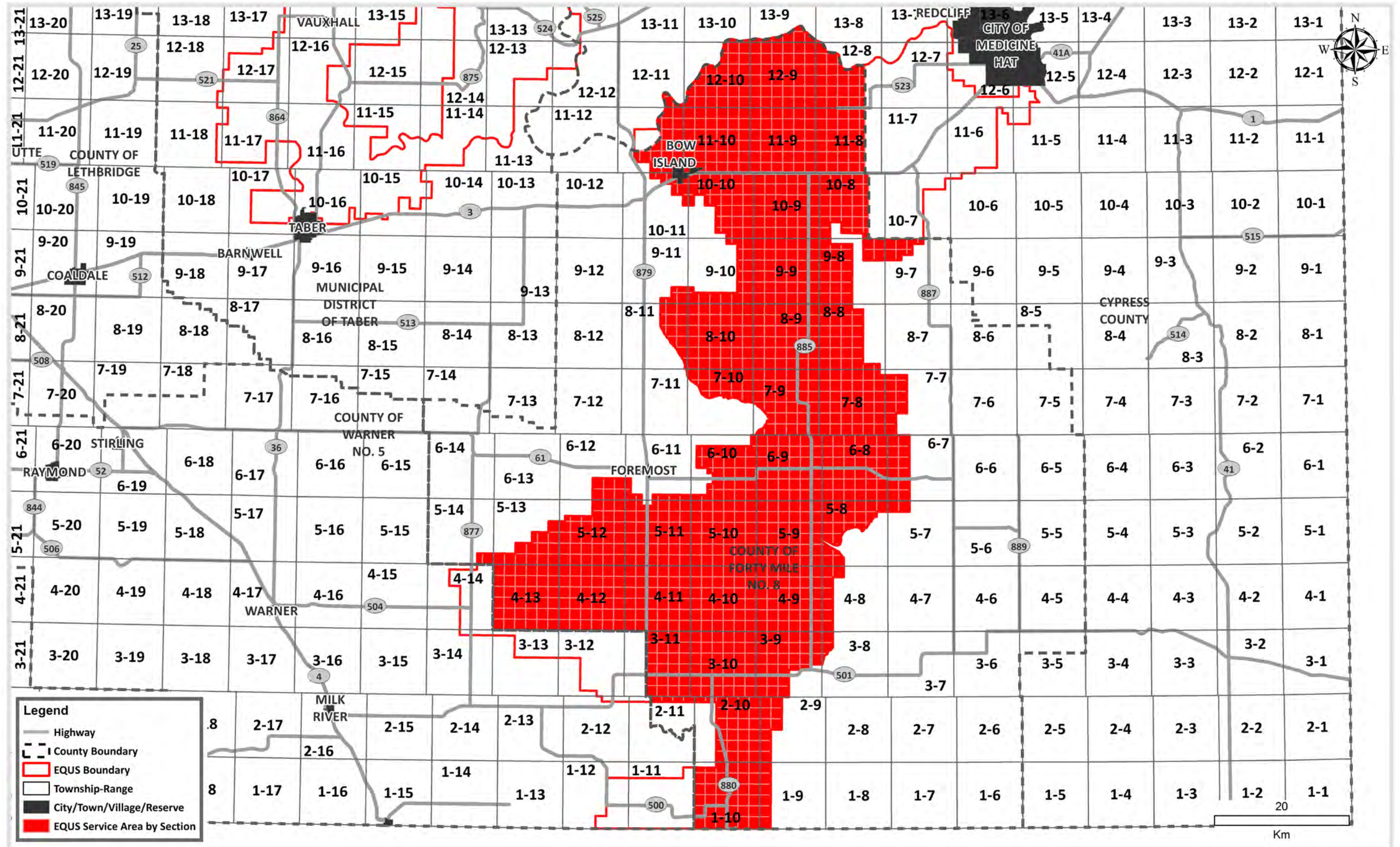






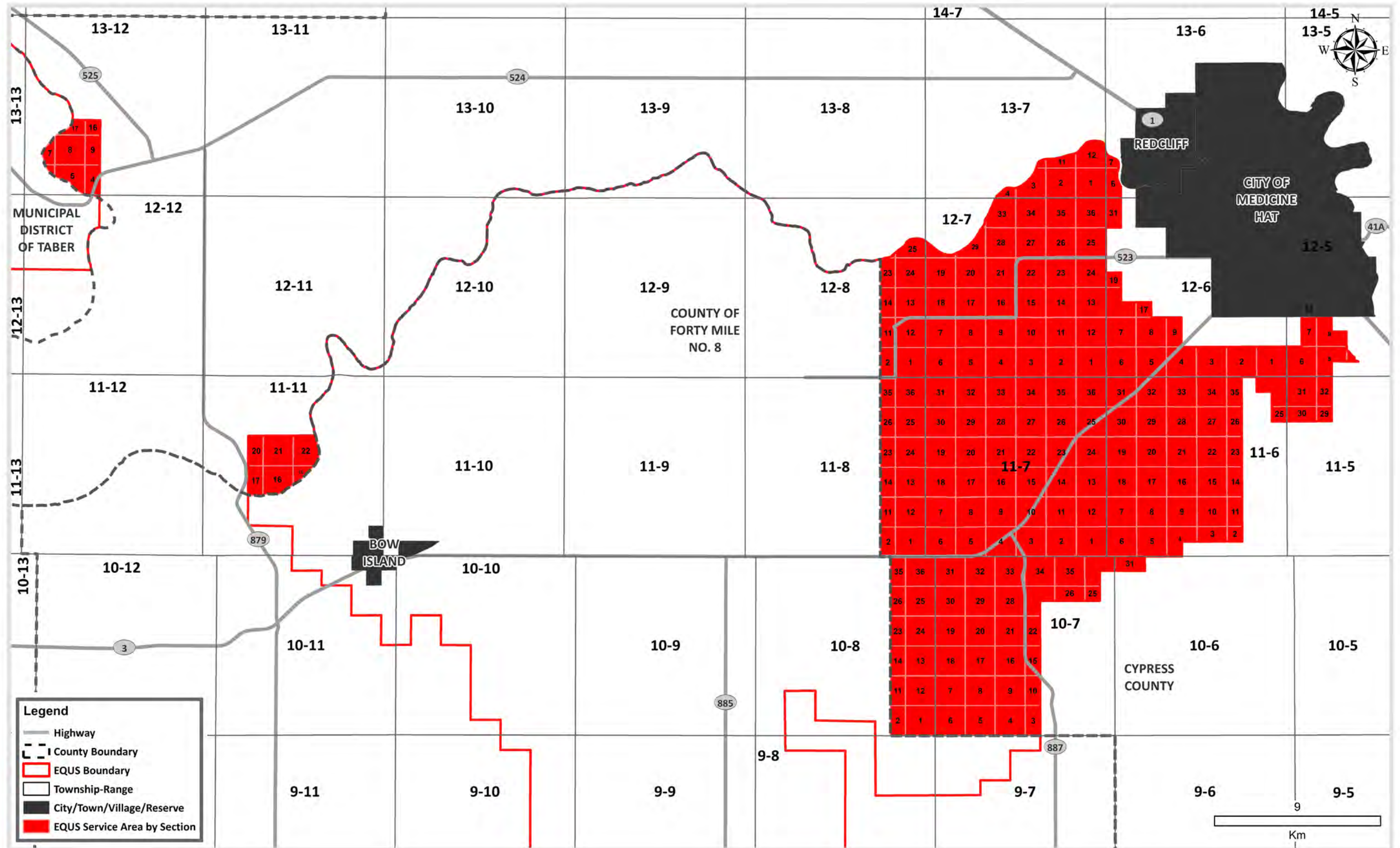


# COUNTY OF FORTY MILE NO. 8



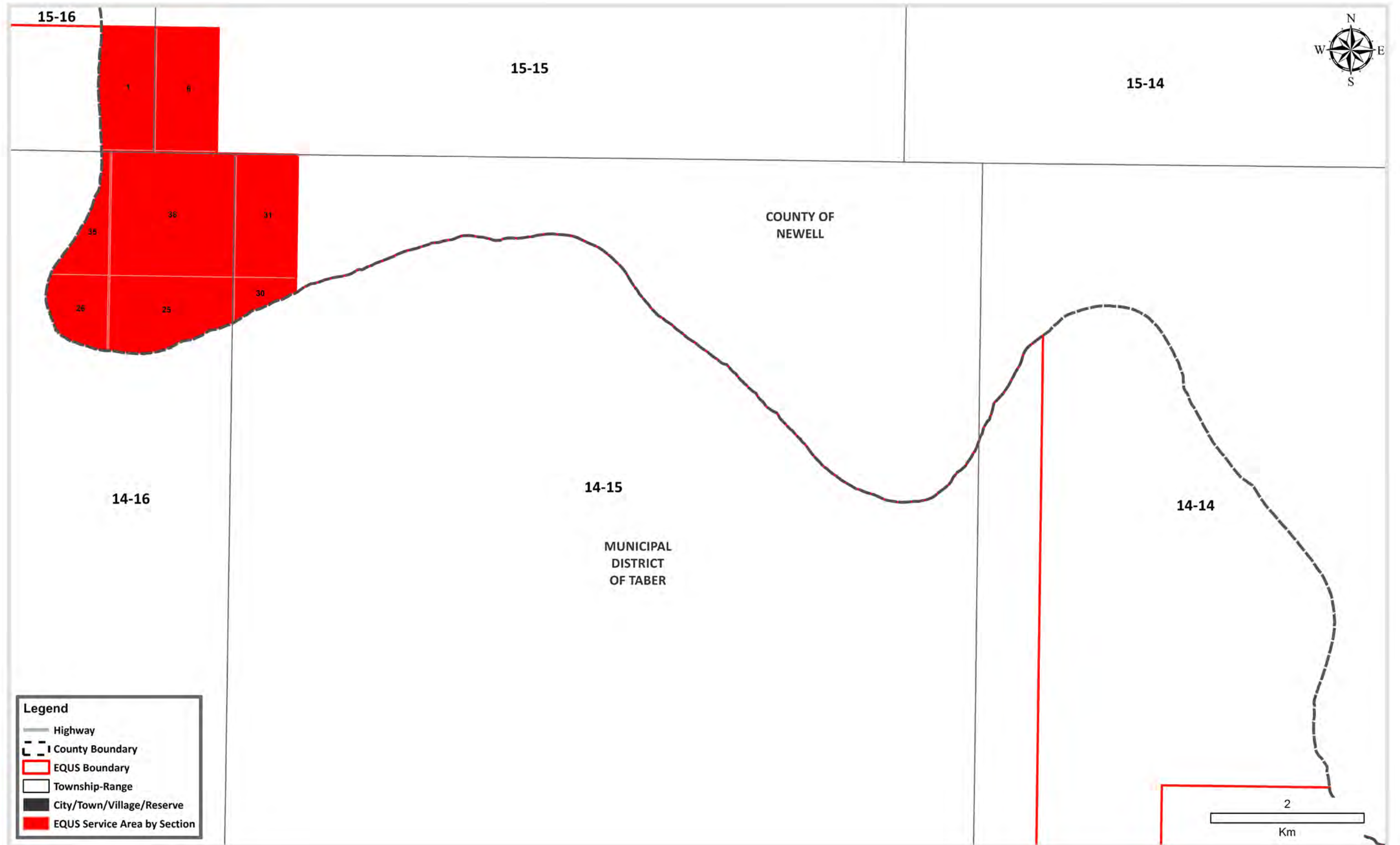

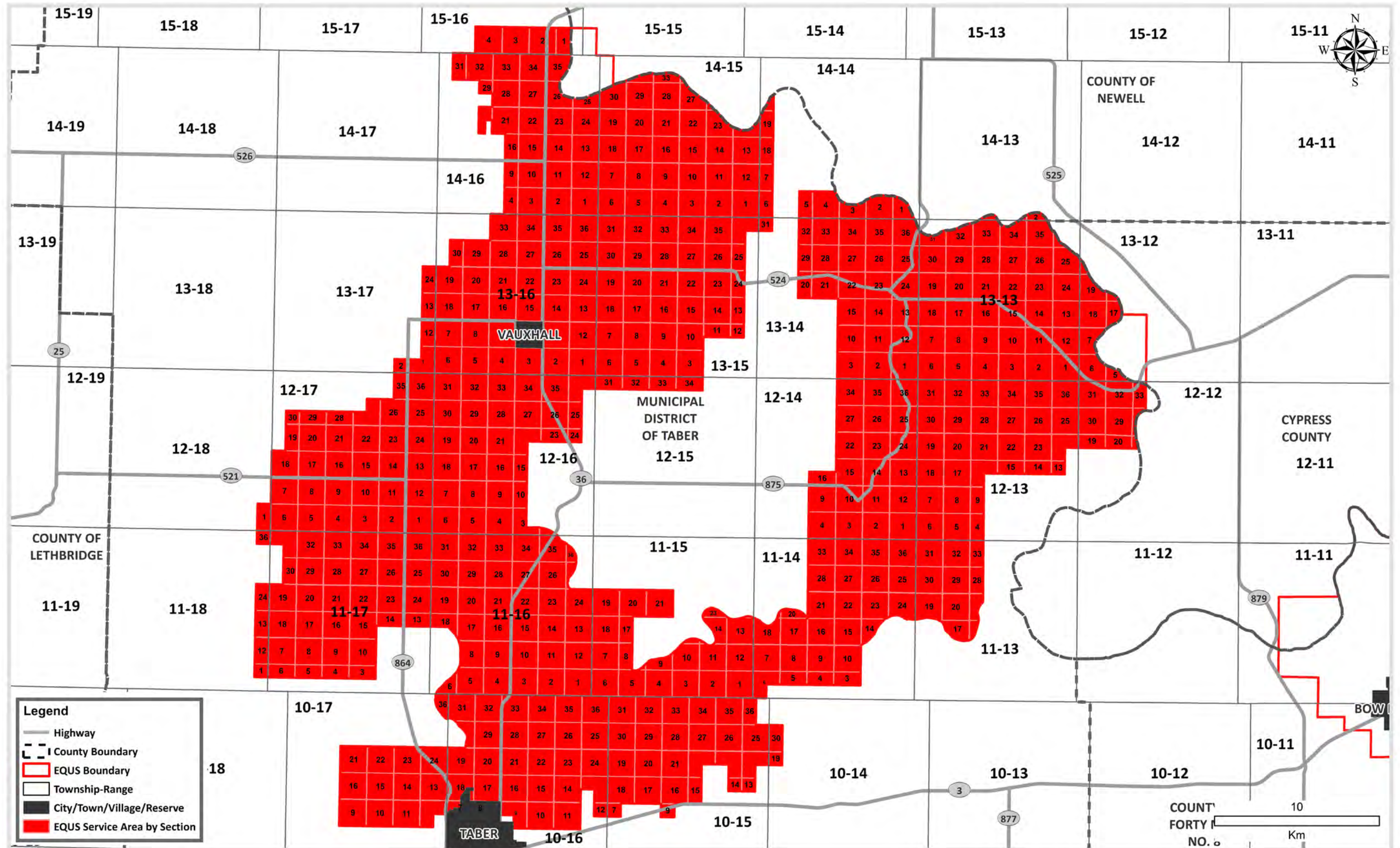

At EQUS we understand the importance of affordability and we provide a flexibility to our members that ensures their rates and service are the best fit for them.
